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Preface

Twenty years have passed since a group of young linguists whose work addresses the study of Slavic languages founded Polyslav at the University of Konstanz (Germany). Every autumn since then the Polyslav meetings have been held at a Central or Eastern European university.

Last year was no exception. So, from 6th to 8th September 2016, the 20th annual International Academic Conference of the Polyslav Association (Polyslav-XX) was held in Moscow (Russia). This jubilee conference was co-organized by the Moscow State Pedagogical University and the Institute for Slavic Studies of the Russian Academy of Sciences. Polyslav-XX was attended by 37 participants from eight countries – most of them from Russia and Poland, but scholars also came from the Czech Republic, Germany, Hungary, Lithuania, Serbia, and Ukraine.

The present proceedings contain 20 papers in four Slavic languages (Russian, Polish, Ukrainian, and Slovene), two in English, and one in German. All 23 contributions meet the basic publishing standards and international editorial conventions, including a double-blind review. In total, 29 reviewers from Europe and the USA guarantee the scientific level of the published papers.

The editors of these proceedings would like to thank the reviewers sincerely for their generous and professional work. Moreover, we would also like to express our gratitude to Harrassowitz's staff for their cooperation and to Prof. Dr. Rehders for including our Proceedings in the series “Die Welt der Slaven – Sammelbände/Сборники”.
